I was Tiana Gould's manager at Amazon Robotics for her fall 2020 co-op, and I am writing to express my endorsement of Tiana as a mechanical engineer. Tiana demonstrated strong engineering fundamentals and design intuition throughout her co-op. In addition to her technical skills, she earned trust with key stakeholders and took ownership over her work. Overall, she operated at the level of a full-time employee and became a valuable member of our team.

First and foremost, Tiana's technical abilities were evident in her design and drawing skills. During her co-op, she owned a sub-assembly and was responsible for taking the concept from sketch to production. Over five months, she transformed a sheet metal prototype into an ergonomic and user friendly design. To ensure her design was well-executed, she held a review with the design team and key stakeholders that was well received. She took feedback from senior engineers, incorporated it appropriately into her final design, and delivered all of her components on time under a tight schedule.

In addition to having a strong engineering foundation, Tiana demonstrated also her ability to learn quickly and grow throughout her co-op. She had little drawing experience when she started working at Amazon Robotics, but quickly learned our best practices and produced high-quality drawings for her parts and sub-assembly. She kept the team informed if there were issues and asked for help when necessary. Tiana was willing to take on a large responsibility and was looking to challenge herself as an engineer. She has a positive attitude, is a team player, and enthusiastic about her work.
